<p><b>Interests</b> – What interests does your child have e.g. hobbies, sports etc.</p> <p>Which days of the week does your child have activities after school?</p>		
<p><b>Behaviour</b> - Does your child have any behavioural issues? What are they and how do they show themselves?</p>
