



HAMPTON HILL SCHOOL CYBERSAFETY USER AGREEMENT FOR STUDENTS

Read this carefully, then keep it to enable you to read it again later. That way you will not forget what it says.

- To use the Internet at school I must have read, signed, and handed in this User Agreement.
- School computers are to help me with classroom learning. They are not for play.
- It is important to keep safe while using the internet and e-mail. This means I must follow the school's safety rules if anything unusual appears while I am working I will:
 - Walk away
 - Tell an adult
 - Not show other students
- The only time I can use the Internet and email at school is when a teacher/teacher aide/parent helper is supervising me.
- I am not allowed to try and look things up on the internet which I know are not for children (i.e.) pornography, information which may be dangerous. Some of it is against the law. If I do not understand I will ask the teacher.
- I must be sensible when using the internet and other communications technologies e.g. mobile phone, digital camera, web camera, including similar technologies still being developed at Hampton Hill School. I know that I must not do anything that would hurt me or someone else, even as a joke.

I agree that:

- I will take care of our computers
- I will take care of computer equipment
- I know I am not allowed to use school computers for arcade-style games
- I will not copy any software from home to use on a school computer
- I will not print anything without the permission of the teacher
- I will use disks only to back up work or to take work home/back to school

I will be considerate of others using computers:

- I will share the equipment
- I will not deliberately disrupt the computer or the school's network.
- I will not be involved in electronic vandalism, like viruses
- If I accidentally come across dangerous, mean or rude material I will tell the teacher immediately without showing other students.

I will look after myself sensibly

- I will not give anyone on the Internet information about myself or others – this includes addresses and phone numbers.
- I will tell the teacher if I come across any problem or if I am not feeling safe.

I understand that if I break this agreement in any way I may lose the right to use the Internet and computers at school. As well, the school may tell my parent/caregiver and may take disciplinary action against me.
