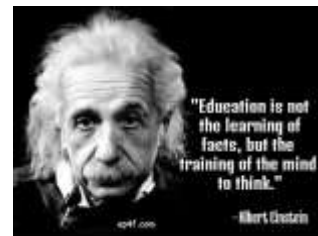

Reunification Drill—thank you:

A big thanks to parents and caregivers for helping to make the reunification drill, held on Wednesday 6 September, a successful operation. The process of gathering on the field and the signing out and collecting of children ran smoothly and by 3pm only three children were left at school and they were picked up soon after. Staff have reviewed the process and made some minor changes to help the operation run more smoothly. From now on the school will undertake a reunification drill once every year.

Re-Roofing the Bottom Block Classrooms:

The Bottom Block is to be re-roofed during the October school break. This means the bottom playground will be part of a work site during the holidays. For health and safety reasons we ask that children and families stay away from this area of the school over the two weeks of the school holidays.
