Localised CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT - Exciting opportunity to engage!

We have now established a visual representation of our localised school curriculum. What does this mean you ask? It is about having a clear picture of "How and what we learn at Hampton Hill School". We want everyone to be able to talk about what learning is happening for our children and know why it is important to learn this. Our goal is to grow people to thrive so they are future ready citizens of the world, grounded by a strong sense of identity and belonging.

I have been reading a lot of research about the future workforce, society's structure and expectation shifts and the impact of AI technology that our children face as well as the impact of technology on communication and learning and I have asked questions about the impact this will have on what we teach and the how we teach.


