Hampton Hill School's flexible response to COVID-19 will depend on the various scenarios that could play out within the school community. The movement between the stages may vary depending on the possible implications of a COVID-19 outbreak. **We are currently in HHS Stage 1.**

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● School is open to all students onsite ● The majority (over 70%) of learners & teachers will be onsite ● Learners that are required to isolate will have access to distance learning (teacher of class provides distance learning) ● Regular learning programmes will continue for those learners onsite 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● School is open to all students on site with a flexible learning programme in place. This means learners offsite will be utilising our distance learning programme and learners onsite will be engaged in normal onsite programmes ● 40% of teachers are offsite (self-isolating or unwell) and/or 30-50% of learners are offsite (self-isolating or unwell) ● In the event of 30-50% of learners being offsite, teachers would be allocated either a distance learning programme role or an onsite teaching role ● Student class groupings onsite may change at this stage 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● School is open to all students onsite ● More than 40% of teachers are offsite (self-isolating or unwell) and/or more than 50% of learners are offsite (self-isolating) ● Whānau will be encouraged to keep learners at home if possible ● Our distance learning programmes will be conducted for learners onsite and offsite ● Student class groupings onsite may change at this stage 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● School is closed to all students onsite ● Over 60% of teachers have been required to self-isolate and cannot be onsite. If possible, distance learning programmes will be accessible for all learners ● If we are unable to provide a structured distance learning problem due to teacher sickness, whānau will be directed to the Hampton Hill School Learning website and the Ministry of Education Learning from Home website
